#### Terms of Competition

- **1.** Tournament Director: the tournament director is Dr. Jackson Were. The assistant tournament director is Paul Charles Rukundo.
- 2. Tournament Referees: The tournament chief referee is Edwin Tumusiime. The other referees are Sadi Atibu and Collins Nuwagira, and their ruling shall be final.
- **3.** Entry and Registration: (a) all ladies intending to play must register and pay before commencement of the tournament. (b) all men intending to play the subsidiary event must register and pay before commencement of the tournament.
- 4. Eligibility: (a) only ladies with a handicap index of 13.6 and below are eligible to play in the ladies silver event and only ladies with a handicap index of 13.7 To 28.5 Are eligible to play in the ladies bronze event. (B) only amateurs with a handicap index of 24.8 And below are eligible to play in the subsidiary (men) event. (C) all players must be affiliated to a golf club.
- 5. Tournament Accreditation: all ladies registered to play in the Uganda Open Golf Championship 2023 shall be accredited on tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2023 at the tournament accreditation centre at the uganda golf club.
- 6. Format and Draws: (a) the ladies silver event will be scratch stroke play over 54 holes (three stipulated rounds of 18 holes) played over 3 days from 12<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> October 2023. (B) the ladies bronze event will be played over 36 holes (two stipulated rounds of 18 holes) over 2 days from 13<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> October 2023. (C) the subsidiary (men) event will be played over 18 holes (one stipulated round of 18 holes) over 1 day on 14<sup>th</sup> october 2023. (D) there will be no requests for time or whom to be drawn with to play.

- **8. Time of Starting and Groups:** rule 5.3a will be adhered to and enforced in all rounds.
- **9.** Pace of Play (rule 5.6b): in the interest of all, a player must not unreasonably delay play, either when playing a hole or between two holes. Players have an obligation to play at a reasonable pace. Slow players must give way. If a group behind is faster, invite them to play through.
- **10. Stopping Play/resuming play (rule 5.7):** (Immediate and normal).

A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signalled by one prolonged air horn. Players must leave the course immediately.

All other suspensions will be signalled by three consecutive air horns, repeated.

In either case, resumption of play will be signalled by two short air horns, repeated.

- **11.** Recording Area and Scorecards Returned: the location of the recording area will be detailed for the competition on the notice board. All scorecards must be completed and submitted to the card checkers within 10 minutes upon leaving the course. A card shall be considered returned when the player leaves the recording area with both feet.
- **12. How to Decide Ties:** in case of a tie for the first position, the players involved in a tie will proceed for a 3-hole playoff starting on the 12<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> holes respectively. If scores are still tied at this point, a sudden death playoff will take place from the 12<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> holes until a winner is decided.

Other ties other than for the 1<sup>st</sup> position will be decided on count back, last 18 holes, last 9 holes, last 6 holes, last 3 holes and then the last one hole.

7. Cut Conditions: there shall be no cut.





- **13. Results of the Competition Competition Closed:** the result of the tournament is officially announced when the final results sheet is placed on the official notice board at the tournament venue.
- **14. Prizes:** the details of the prizes are outlined in appendix one.
- **15. Caddies:** a player is prohibited from having a professional or another player entered in the tournament serve as her caddie during the stipulated round. Caddies for players are available at the Uganda Golf Club. Players are advised that the organising committee shall not guarantee the competence of caddies for any players participating in the event. Caddies will be given bibs and the players are to ensure that their caddies wear the bibs. Caddie fees shall be paid directly by the players for each round of golf at the end of each round. The official caddie fee is ugx 50,000 per round.
- **16. Electronic Equipment:** the use of distance measuring equipment is allowed during a stipulated round. However, the use of cellular phones, smartphones, ipods, walkmans and other like devices are prohibited during a stipulated round. Penalty for breach is disqualification. [To report a medical emergency or to obtain information on rules of golf from the tournament rules team, please contact a nearest available official.]
- **17.** In case of inclement weather, 36 holes of completed rounds will be considered in determining the winners in the silver event.
- **18. Dressing:** all competitors must conform to the Uganda Golf Club dress regulations.



The handicap limit for the subsidiary events can be changed at the discretion of the tournament director, depending on the number of registrations. (C) all amateurs must be affiliated to a golf club.

- **5. Tournament accreditation:** all amateurs registered to play in the Uganda Open Golf Championship 2023 shall be accredited on Saturday 14th October and monday 16th October 2023 at the tournament accreditation centre at the Uganda Golf Club.

(B) the subsidiary events will be played over 18 holes (one stipulated round of 18 holes) on friday 20th October 2023 for group c and on saturday 21st October 2023 for group b. (C) there will be no requests for time or whom to be drawn with to play.

#### Terms of Competition

- 1. **Tournament Director:** the tournament director is Dr. Jackson Were. The assistant tournament director is Paul Charles Rukundo.
- 2. **Tournament Referees:** the tournament chief referee is David Kihara. The other referees are Edwin Tumusiime, Evah Magala and Gloria Mbaguta, and their ruling shall be final.
- 3. Entry and Registration: all professionals intending to play must register and pay before commencement of the tournament. The entry fee for professionals is USD 130 but for Safari Tour members it is USD 70.
- 4. **Eligibility:** (a) only professionals and invited amateurs are eligible to play in the Professionals Open main event. (b) all professionals must belong to a PGA.
- 5. **Tournament Accreditation:** (a) all professional players who have paid the entry fees shall be accredited on Saturday 21st October and Monday 23rd October 2023 at the tournament accreditation centre. (b) all professionals must sign the physical register at the Uganda Golf Club by Tuesday 24th October 2023 in order to be put on the draw.
- 6. Format and Draws: (a) stroke play over 72 holes (four stipulated rounds of 18 holes) played over 4 days from 25th to 28th October 2023. (b) the subsidiary events will be played over 18 holes (one stipulated round of 18 holes) over one day on 27th October 2023 for groups a & c and on 28th October 2023 for group b. (c) there will be no requests for time or whom to be drawn with to play.
- 7. **Cut Conditions:** (a) any professional player shooting 86 or higher during the first round will be cut from the field. (b) only 30 professionals (plus ties) after 36 holes shall make the cut. (c) amateurs who make the cut will be eligible to apply to join the Uganda Professional Golfers Association subject to entry conditions.
- 8. **Time of Starting and Groups:** rule 5.3a will be adhered to and enforced in all rounds.



9. Pace of Play (rule 5.6b): in the interest of all, a player must not unreasonably delay play, either when playing a hole or between two holes. Players have an obligation to play at a reasonable pace. Slow players must give way. If a group behind is faster, invite them to play through.

#### 10. **Stopping Play/Resuming Play (Rule 5.7):** (Immediate and normal).

A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signalled by one prolonged air horn. Players must leave the course immediately.

All other suspensions will be signalled by three consecutive air horns, repeated.

In either case, resumption of play will be signalled by two short air horns, repeated.

- 11. Recording Area and Scorecards Returned: the location of the recording area will be detailed for the competition on the notice board. All scorecards must be completed and submitted to the card checkers within 10 minutes upon leaving the course. A card shall be considered returned when the player leaves the recording area with both feet.
- 12. **Results of The Competition Competition Closed:** the result of the tournament is officially announced when the final results sheet is placed on the official notice board at the tournament venue.
- 13. **Prize Money Eligibility:** only professional players who make the cut after 36 holes shall be paid.

- 16. Ties For First Position: in case of a tie for the first position in the professional open, the winner shall be decided by a three hole playoff starting on the 12th, 17th and 18th holes respectively. If scores are still tied at this point, a sudden death playoff will take place from the 12th, 17th and 18th holes until a decision is reached. The playoff winner shall win first place money in which case the playoff runner-up gets the second place money. If a playoff has three or more participants, then the winner shall get first place money, while the losers, who are all deemed to be tied for 2nd place, will receive equal money shares as explained in the "ties for any position other than first place" section above.
- 17. Caddies: a player is prohibited from having a professional or another player entered in the tournament serve as his caddie during the stipulated round. Caddies for players are available at the Uganda Golf Club. Players are advised that the organising committee shall not guarantee the competence of caddies for any players participating in the event. Caddies will be given bibs and the players are to ensure that their caddies wear the bibs. Caddie fees shall be paid directly by the players for each round of golf at the end of each round. The official caddie fee is ugx 60,000 per round.
- **18. Dressing:** all competitors must conform to the uganda golf club dress regulations.
